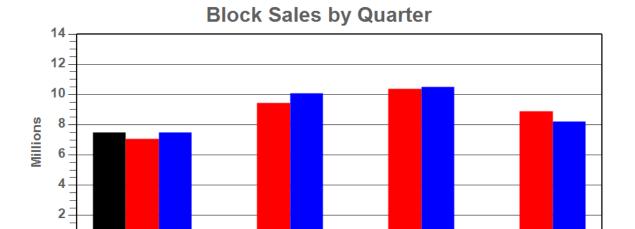

Block Sales - Trailing Twelve Months

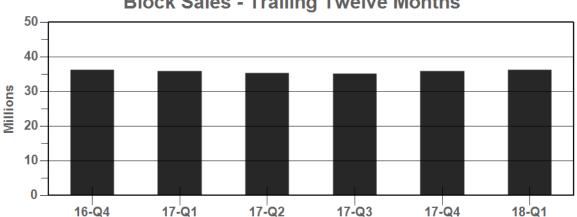
